

# Sociolinguistic Workshops (ASL)

Sociolinguistic workshops are courses designed for people of foreign origin or not, to help them learn the French language.

These workshops aim to facilitate their integration by addressing practical everyday topics.

## Target Audience:

- People wishing to gain autonomy in their daily lives (everyday life, administrative procedures, support for children's schooling, socioprofessional integration projects, etc.)
- > Adults in general (minors under certain conditions)
- Those in the process of literacy, post-literacy, French as a Foreign Language (FLE), or French as an Integration Language (FLI learning the language through immersion with the goal of better integrating into France) or those needing a refresher course

### **Objectives:**

- Learn French to achieve autonomy.
- Improve skills, particularly oral skills, to be autonomous in various communication situations of everyday life; initiation or reinforcement of written skills.
- Break isolation and facilitate involvement and participation in local and social life.

### **Operating Procedures:**

- Sessions run from September to June, every Tuesday from 2:15 PM to 4:15 PM.
- No sessions during school holidays.
- Possibility to join the group during the year.
- Option to participate in the Friday class from 2:15 PM to 4:15 PM at the Equipage Sociocultural Center, 16 rue de Saint Galmier, 42140 Chazelles sur Lyon.

### Facilitation and Supervision:

- Sessions are conducted by a team of volunteers who are regularly accompanied and trained.
- A qualified instructor in teaching French as a Foreign Language is present on Fridays at the Equipage Sociocultural Center.

### **Educational Materials:**

• Materials are selected based on the learners' needs and everyday life realities.

### Integration with the Village:

Possible participation in other activities offered by the association (family outings, adult activities, etc.) to
promote social integration.

### **Registration:**

- Registration of the beneficiary follows a personalized approach: Initial meeting, needs assessment with the volunteer, gathering of needs, attendance tracking.
- Voluntary participation (no prescription required).
- Courses are free, but membership in the social center is required. It costs €4 for the entire year.
